Family Dispute Resolution (FDR) is a type of mediation which helps people who are separating or divorcing to resolve their family law disputes with each other. It involves an impartial third party, called a Family Dispute Resolution Practitioner (FDRP), or mediator. This person is independent of the people actually involved in the dispute. FDR is regulated by the Family Law Act 1975

You should ensure that that affidavit also sets out those matters which you rely upon to file your applications without filing a certificate from a family dispute resolution practitioner. You do not need to complete this affidavit if there is a consent order or if you are applying for orders in response to an application.

Applications for dispute resolution must be made within two years of ending a tenancy. If one of the parties files a claim during that period, the other party can make a separate claim – even if the two-year deadline has passed. However, the separate claim must be made before the first claim is heard.

You must include a certificate from a family dispute resolution practitioner with your court application saying that you've been to, or attempted to go to, family dispute resolution, or that it's their opinion that it's not appropriate for you to go.
