To do so, highlight your VM in VirtualBox's main menu and click Settings. Visit the Storage tab on the left and you should see a CD icon in the Storage Tree box. Click that icon, then the CD with an arrow next to it on the right side. Select Choose Virtual Optical Disc File and then browse to where you saved the Windows.iso file.
